Fire Safety Advice

- 1. Keep the size of the fire to a minimum so it won't collapse to one side once lit.
- 2. Build it well away from any tree, shed, fence, greenhouse, poly tunnel, weed suppressant material or any combustible material not intended for burning.
- 3. Be careful what you wear as loose clothing can catch alight easily
- 4. Don't light fires in windy conditions as flames and smoke can quickly change direction.
- 5. Never use petrol or paraffin to start a fire use household firelighters or newspapers.
- 6. Keep any accelerants (i.e. petrol cans for mowers) well away from the fire as they are a potential hazard.
- 7. Before you light a fire check that animals are not hiding inside and that no-one has placed any unsafe rubbish on it.
- 8. Never burn aerosols, paint, gas canisters, foam furniture or batteries. (pollution/explosions)
- 9. Don't leave a fire unattended or leave children without supervision
- 10. All material should be consumed before leaving the fire.
- 11. Remember that you are responsible for your own safety and the safety of others.
